I cannot tell - can you?

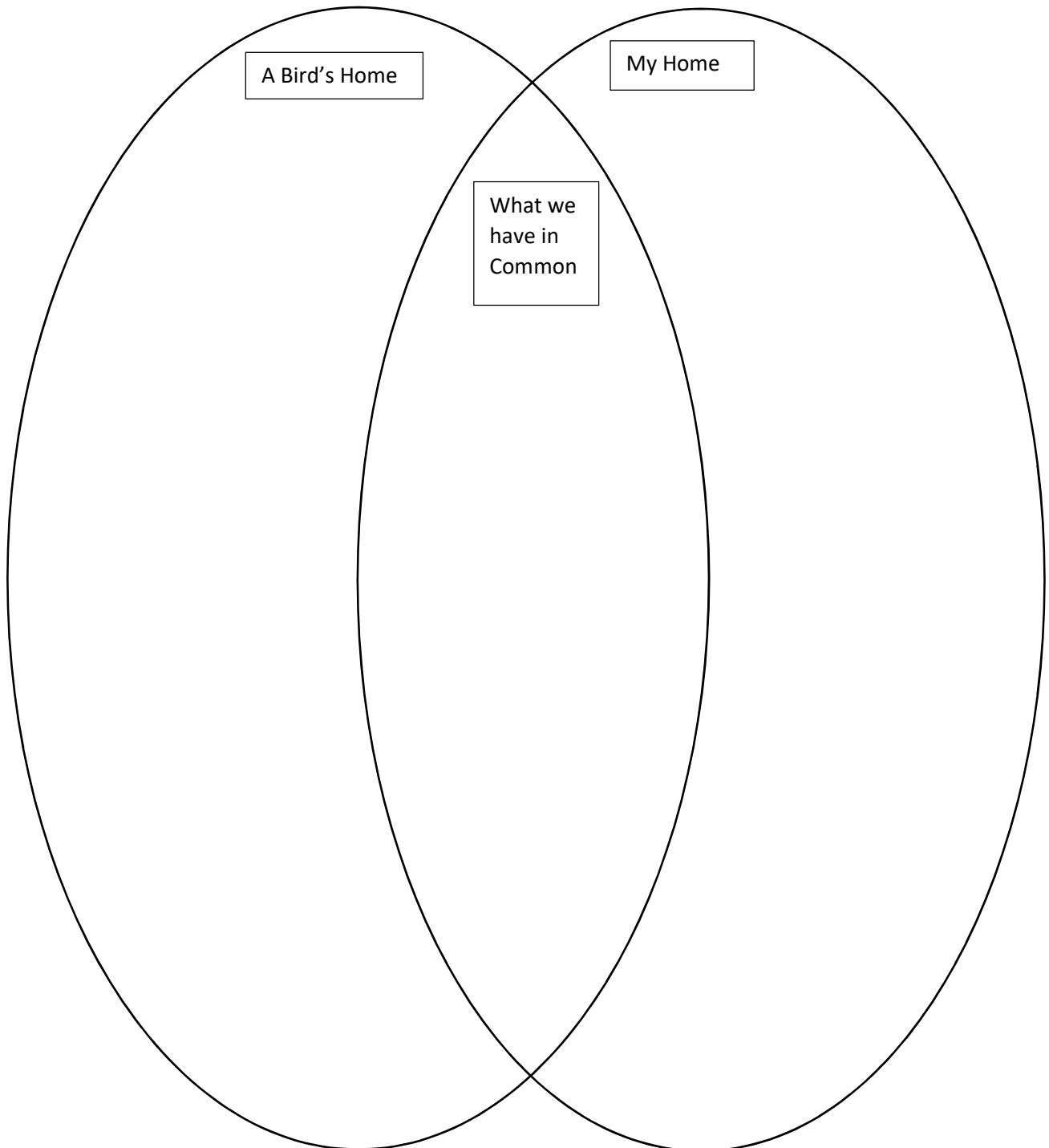
### Discussion questions:
