Description

Here you would experience short winter days, and midnight sun in summer. For seven months of the year, the temperatures are sub-zero.

The region is no wetter than the temperate zone, maybe drier.

This region has four seasons: no extremes of temperatures. It's tepid; year-round rainfall, and summer may be the wettest season.

This region has intense sunshine that ripens citrus fruits. People in this region take a siesta in the hotter months to cope with the heat. The rainy season makes up for very dry months.

This region is very dry; less than 250 mm of rain on an average. The temperatures peak in summer months at 40°C or more. Temperatures can drop 20° C between midday and midnight.

This region has high temperatures all year round. It is also wet, wet, wet! Rainfall totals 2000 mm a year. There are two seasons: wet and dry (or drier)
