

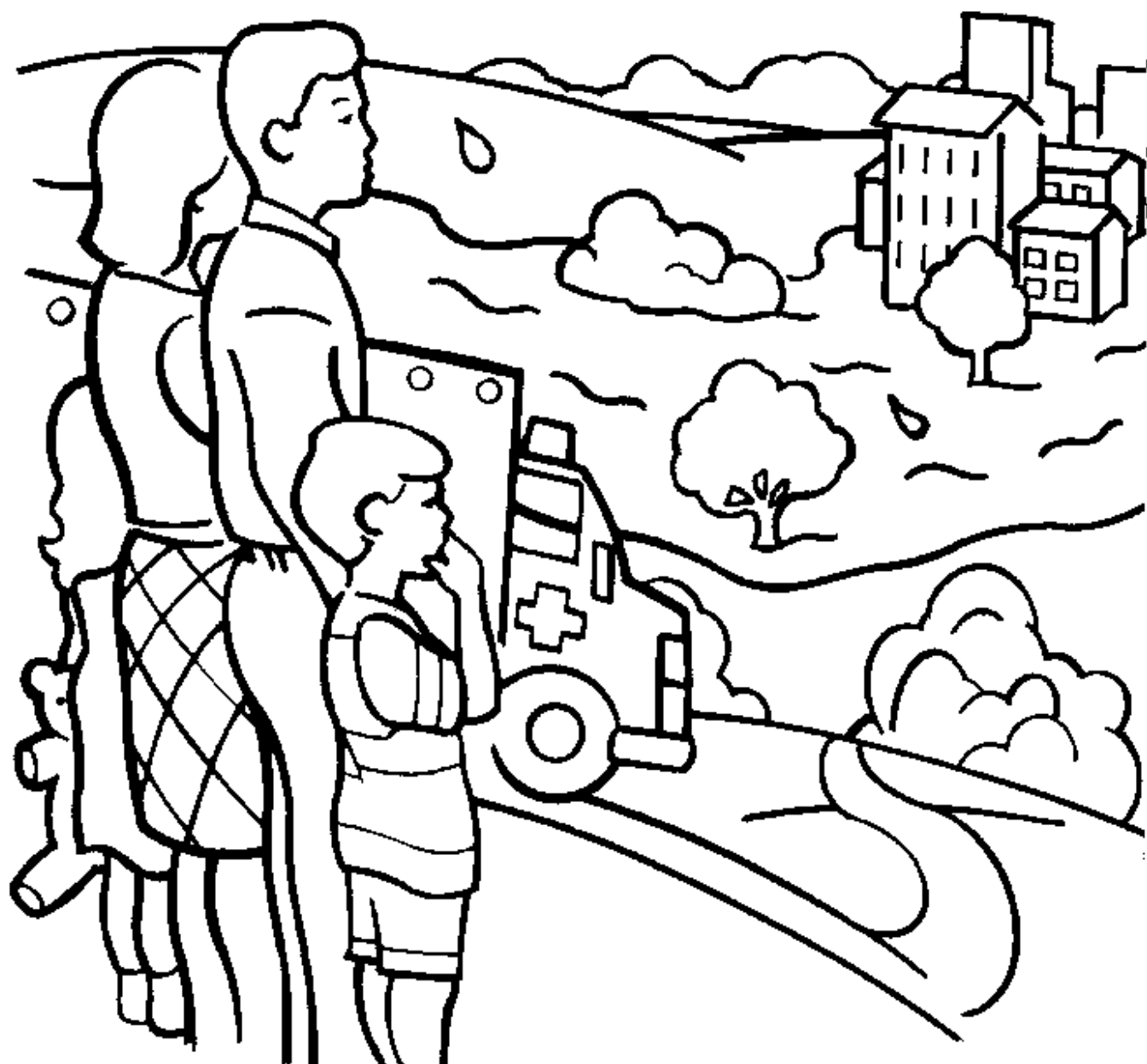
FLOOD AND DROUGHT

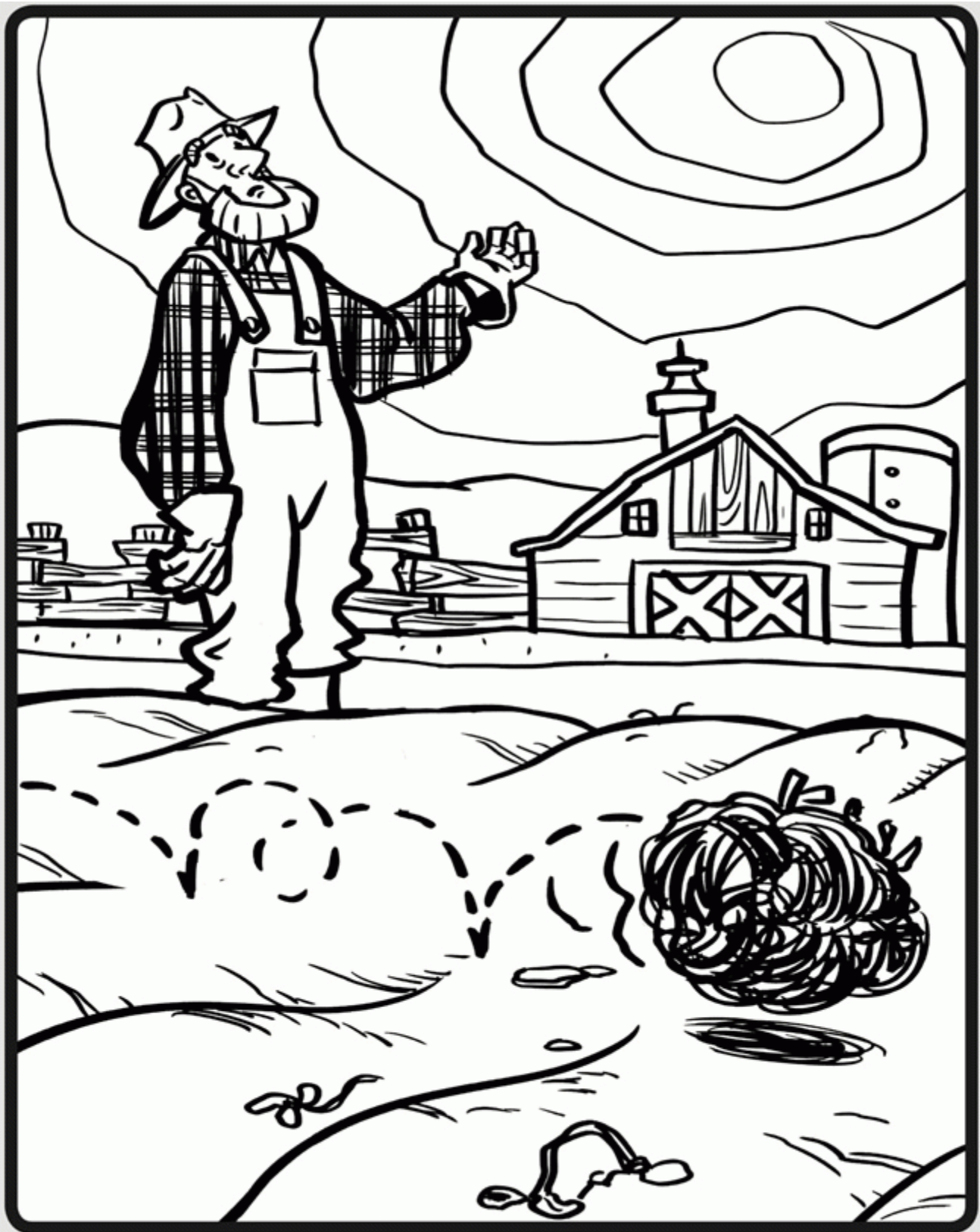
