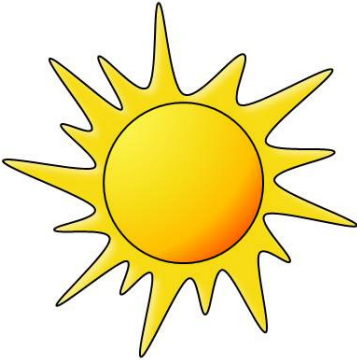

Cloudy



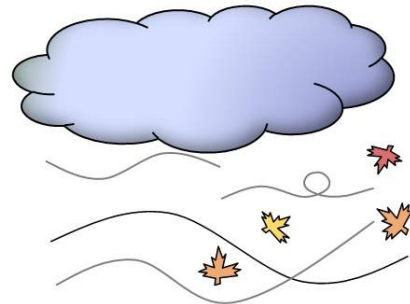
Stormy
