3. Why must we love and be strong?

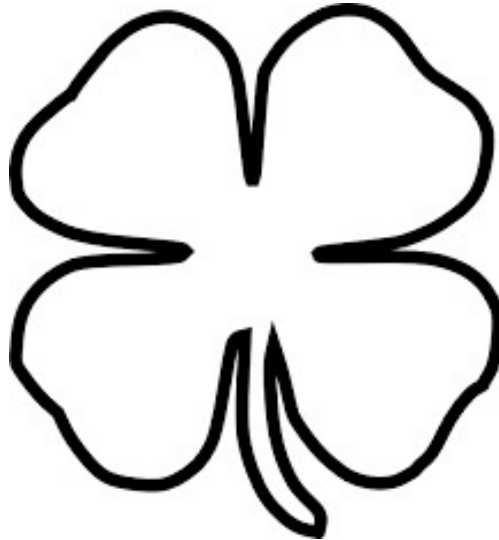
Discuss
