## Grammar: Pronouns

*I* and ***me*** are both personal pronouns. You use them as a substitute for someone's name.

*I* is the subject of a sentence or a clause and it is used at the beginning of a sentence and right before a verb.

Example: *I* like to write.

***Me*** is the object of a sentence or a clause and it is used at the end of a sentence and after a verb or a preposition.

Example: Jerry give ***me*** \$20.
