## Compound Words

When two or more separate words join to form a new word, that word is called a compound word.

Three types of compound words

1. Closed. Example butterfly. (There is no space between the joined words)
2. Hyphenated. Mother-in-law ( the words are joined with a hyphen)
3. Open. Living room (the words are joined with a space)

Our focus will be on closed compound words.
