MORPHEME

is the most elemental grammatical unit in the given language. A single word may be composed of one or more morphemes:

one morpheme: boy

two morphemes: boy+ ish

three morphemes: boy+ish+ness

four morphemes: un+ desire+able+ity



What are morphemes?

 A morpheme is the smallest unit of meaning or grammatical function.

boys girls

A morpheme can be a root word, prefix, or suffix.

<u>like</u> <u>un</u>like like<u>ly</u>

Most words are more than one morpheme long, but a morpheme is not the same as a syllable.

likable (3 syllables, 2 morphemes)
